

AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Please check your spam/adjust your settings if you think you did not receive it.

Next term's after-school activities will commence the week beginning Monday 16th January 2023, and run for ten weeks. **Bookings opened yesterday at 1pm.** Activities have a limited availability, with prices from £5.00 to £7.00 per session. **Places are booked on a first-come, first served basis. Parents of children eligible for the benefit Free School Meals, who are entitled to one free activity, should contact the school office after setting up their account.**



HELP FOR LOW-INCOME FAMILIES

The Royal Borough of Greenwich are concerned that many families do not know that they can access extra help and entitlements (such as free school meals, school clothing/journey grants and social security benefits) because they don't know they can claim. There are also local and national schemes to help residents struggling with rising living costs.
