

TRANSITION TO RECEPTION

The Young Greenwich School Nursing Service are offering parent drop-in sessions on the following dates:

- Thursday 22nd June 2023 at Avery Hill Youth Hub from 2pm to 3pm
- Wednesday 28th June 2023 at Valley Central Youth Hub from 12pm to 1pm

These sessions are open to all families of school-aged children across Greenwich and, although the topic for these sessions is ostensibly the Transition to Reception, parents are welcome to discuss any health concerns they may have.



NO PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL

We remind all parents not to park in the restricted areas on the roads surrounding the school, particularly the roads surrounding our Royal Hill Campus. REGISTER FOR FREE/SUBSIDISED MILK

School milk is FREE for children under the age of five, FREE to children entitled to Free School Meals and subsidised for all other children in primary education, meaning parents will pay around £15 per term. BREAKFAST CLUB BOOKING

Breakfast Club is available for booking via our online booking system, with bookings by the day or term available. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis and are limited. To book. please go to the SchoolHire website at https://jameswolfe.schoolactivity.co.uk. If you would like to cancel a booking, please request this from the school office, who will generate an automatic refund for any session that has not yet taken place. Please note, however, that only whole bookings can be cancelled, not individual days from a booking -- we would have to cancel the whole booking and you would then have to re-book for just the days you require.

Please can we remind parents that pupils must arrive for Breakfast Club by 8:30am.

The charge for the week remains at £12.50 (£2.50 per day), which must be paid when making the booking. Parents with Pupil Premium children or those who wish to pay with childcare vouchers must contact the school office before setting up a SchoolHire account, or they will be charged as normal.
