

The booking letter for September's Breakfast Club was sent out to parents yesterday (Wednesday). Booking will be available from Midday on Friday (7th July).

Places at Breakfast Club (both campuses) must be booked in advance. If parents find they are unable to book, for example there are no spaces, they must email admin@jameswolfe.greenwich.sch.uk to ask if there are any spaces available. Please can parents note that they must book for their child to attend.

The price of Breakfast Club provision will increase in September to £3.50 per day.

The start and finish times of Breakfast Club are: Randall Place 8am to 9am and Royal Hill 7.45am to 8.45am. Children may arrive any time up to 15 minutes before the end.


