

BREE'S LITTLE STARS

Bree's Little Stars would like to update you on their provision for September 2023, as well as welcoming both new parents and Nursery children. They are very much looking forward to seeing you and your children at their After-School Club (for Reception to Year 6), and have lots of fun activities ready to entertain them. They will also be launching their new Breakfast Club for Nursery children, which will run Monday to Friday from 7:45am to 8:45am at a cost of £7 per session, with September booking now available on their Cheqdin System (for both Breakfast Club and A-SC). They will not be running a Breakfast Club for Reception to Year 6, as this is something already provided by the school.

Their After-School Clubs at Randall Place and Royal Hill run Monday to Friday from 3:15pm to 6:05pm, term time only. Please book well in advance to guarantee your space. Snacks are provided daily, including a fruit & vegetable platter, sandwiches, wraps & soups. Milk and water are also provided. Activities available to the children include Lego, sip & paint, music & dance, board games, arts & crafts, outdoor play (with footballs, basketballs & tennis balls available), cards, Play Dough, puzzles and homework! Children's ideas are also encouraged & welcomed.

Approximate schedule: 3:30pm-4:15pm food/snacks, 4:15pm-5:00pm outdoor play, 5:00pm-5:45pm activities, 5:45pm-6:00pm tidy up, 6:00pm reflect on day's events.
