PE is on a Thursday morning this term and will focus on tennis and netball. In Autumn term 2 we will swap the activity the classes attend so all children will have an opportunity to learn the skills and develop their understanding of both sports. Please bring the PE kits in for their first lesson and leave the PE kit in school for the half term.
