As you will know, a smooth transition is extremely important and so transition is planned very carefully at James Wolfe in order to support the children and ensure it is a positive experience. The purpose of this newsletter is to share our plans for next year with you in a timely way. As many of you know, we like to have a series of opportunities for the children to meet their new class teacher and we call these Transition Afternoons. The children will welcome their new teacher to their new classroom on Monday 3rd July and again on Wednesday 12th July. During these sessions, the teacher will do activities which support them in getting to know the children. As always, current teachers and new teachers will all have dedicated and thorough handover meetings, where every child in every class is discussed ready for September. Our new teachers will also be joining the team to plan for our exciting Autumn curriculum!

We are extremely sad to say goodbye to our Year 6 classes. They have been such a brilliant group of children, who have bonded and worked extremely hard this year – their learning behaviour has been fantastic. Despite the challenges that they have faced over previous years, the children are more than ready for secondary school, both academically and emotionally. They have been fantastic role models for the rest of the school – I know that there will be a few tears, not only from the children but also the members of staff who have loved teaching them. We are very aware that the jump from the Early Years Foundation Stage to Key Stage 1 is a big one. 












